If you are applying for a fireworks operator certificate (Display Assistant or Pyrotechnician) for the first time you must:

- Be at least 18 years or older
- Successfully complete a safety and legal awareness course for Display Fireworks or Special Effect Pyrotechnics.
- If you want to apply online for a fireworks operator certificate, you will need to be enrolled in eServices.
- Note that you will enroll as an Individual.

After you have completed your enrolment, you will proceed to the My Personal Licences, Permits, and Certificates link to apply for a new certificate.

You will need:

- your proof of successful completion of safety and legal awareness course
- A digital photo showing a full front view of your head and shoulders. Use a plain, contrasting background without shadows. No hats. The photos should be recent – taken within the last 12 months
- A way to pay (VISA, MasterCard, American Express or you can choose the option to pay later and send a certified cheque or money order)

Renewing your F.O.C.

You will receive a notice by mail, or E-Mail(if registered online) at least 2 months prior to expiry

- 1. Log into the eLMS
- 2. Go to the My Personal Licenses, Permits and Certificate Link
- 3. Click on : View YOUR License, Permits, and Certificates
- 4. Select the license You wish to change
- 5. Click on Renew

To Renew Online you will need:

- A digital photo showing a full front view of your head and shoulders. Use a plain, contrasting background without shadows. No hats. The photos should be recent taken within the last 12 months
- A way to pay (VISA, MasterCard, American Express or you can choose the option to pay later and send a certified cheque or money order by mail)

Upgrading your F.O.C.

To Upgrade your F.O.C. you must Apply to the ERD and meet the requirements outlined below

- 1. Log into the eLMS
- 2. Go to the My Personal Licenses, Permits and Certificate Link
- 3. Click on : View YOUR License, Permits, and Certificates
- 4. Select the license You wish to change
- 5. Click on Upgrade

To Upgrade Online you will need:

- A Work Journal
- A letter of Recommendation
- A digital photo showing a full front view of your head and shoulders. Use a plain, contrasting background without shadows. No hats. The photos should be recent – taken within the last 12 months
- A way to pay (VISA, MasterCard, American Express or you can choose the option to pay later and send a certified cheque or money order by mail)

Display Supervisor	 Certification as a Display Assistant Participated in a minimum of three shows within five years Letter of recommendation from Lead Supervisor in Charge
Display Supervisor with Endorsements	 Certification as a Display Supervisor First endorsement - act as Lead Supervisor in Charge for at least three shows For each endorsement - participated in at least three shows in the past five years in which you have assisted with displays that include the endorsement Letter of recommendation from a Lead Supervisor in Charge of a show that includes the endorsement where you participated as crew.
Senior Pyrotechnician	 Certification as a Pyrotechnician for one year Work Journal Letter of recommendation from a Supervisor with a higher certification
Special Effects Pyrotechnician	 Certification as a Senior Pyrotechnician for one year Work Journal -Letter of recommendation from a Supervisor with a higher certification
Special Effects Pyrotechnician – detonating cord	 Certification as a Special Effects Pyrotechnician for one year - Work Journal Letter of recommendation from a Supervisor with a higher certification - Proof of Security Screening
